#28 Tommy O'Regan: In 32 games with Harvard University he posted 15 points (three goals, 12 assists) and a +3 rating. O'Regan finished 2nd on the team in assists (12) and 6th on the team in points (15)...As a freshman in 2011-12 he was named ECAC Hockey Rookie of the Week on Feb 21...Attending Prospect Camp as a tryout.

#50 Chris Tierney: In 68 games with the London Knights Tierney posted 57 points (18 goals, 39 assists), 5 PPG, a +6 rating, and 12 PIMs. He finished the regular season ranked 4th on his team in assists (39) and 5th in points (57)...Tierney won the 2013 OHL Robertson Cup with London, finishing the postseason 6th on his team in goals (6), 4th in assists (15), and 5th in points (21)...Drafted by San Jose in 2012 (2nd Round, 55th overall).

#56 Brodie Reid: Played in 34 games with the Worcester Sharks, registering 21 points (10 goals, 11 assists), 19 PIMs, and one fighting major...Signed by San Jose as a free agent on Apr. 15, 2011.

#60 Brian Ward: Played in 42 games for the Tri-City Storm in the USHL, logging 54 points (22 goals, 32 assists), a +10 rating, and 69 PIMs. He ranked T-2nd on his team in goals, 3rd on his team in assists (32), and 3rd on his team in points. Amongst all USHL players, Ward ranked 23rd in assists (32) and 25th in points...Attending Prospect Camp as a tryout.

#67 Travis Oleksuk: Played in 60 games with Worcester, posting 13 points (three goals, 10 assists), 12 PIMs, and 76 shots in his first professional season...In 2011-12 with Minnesota-Duluth, he was named to WCHA Third All-Star Team, finished T-2nd in the WCHA in points (53) and ranked 4th overall in the nation in points. Furthermore, Oleksuk scored six game-winning goals to lead the team...54th Minnesota-Duluth player ever to reach 100 point career mark and holds school record with 15 career game-winning goals...Signed by San Jose as a free agent on Mar. 30, 2012.

#71 Daniil Tarasov: In 43 games with the Worcester Sharks Tarasov posted 28 points (14 goals, 14 assists), 20 PIMs, and 121 shots. He was named the Worcester Sharks Rookie of the Year. With the San Francisco Bulls of the ECHL, he registered 14 points (three goals, 11 assists) in 17 games...Signed by San Jose as free agent on Apr. 2, 2013.

#72 Rylan Schwartz: In 41 games with Colorado College, Schwartz posted 53 points (20 goals, 33 assists) a +10 rating, and 35 PIMs. Amongst all NCAA players he ranked 1st in points (53), 13th in goals (20), and 3rd in assists (33). He was named to the All-WCHA team as well as the All-WCHA Academic Team...In seven games with the Worcester Sharks, Schwartz had four points (one goal, three assists) and a +1 rating and logged an assist in his first professional game...Signed by San Jose as a free agent on Apr. 5, 2013.

#73 Chris Crane: Played 38 games with Ohio State University, registering nine points (six goals, three assists). During his career with the Buckeyes, Crane was a two-time Ohio State Scholar-Athlete, an Academic All-Big Ten choice, and a Perani Cup winner. He also shared team's Leading Scorer award in 2011-12 with 24 points (14 goals, 10 assists)...Drafted by San Jose in 2010 (7th Round, 200th overall).

#75 Freddie Hamilton: In his first pro season Hamilton played in all 76 games with the Worcester Sharks, the only player to suit up in all 76 games. He registered 26 points (13 goals, 13 assists), 26 PIMs, and 107 shots. Hamilton led team with 2 shorthanded goals and also led the team with four game winning goals...Drafted by San Jose in 2010 (5th Round, 129th overall).

#78 Lane Scheidl: In 72 games played with the Regina Pats, Scheidl served as the team's Alternate Captain and posted 80 points (41 goals, 39 assists) and 62 PIMs. He was named Regina Pats Player of the Year, the Pats Molson Three Stars Award Winner, was 1st on the Regina Pats in goals (41), was 2nd in assists (39), 1st with 16 PPGs, and ranked 1st on the team in points (80)...Signed by Worcester as a free agent on Mar. 21, 2013.

#79 Cody Ferriero: Registered 26 points (12 goals, 14 assists) and 60 PIMs in 34 games with Northeastern. Ferriero finished the season 2nd on his team in goals (12) and 3rd on his team in points (26). He also ranked 2nd in Hockey East and tied for 11th nationally with seven power play goals...Scored four goals against Harvard on Dec. 29, 2012, becoming the first Husky since 1982 and one of only three NCAA players this season to score four goals in a single game...Named Hockey East Co-Player of the Week on Jan. 2...Drafted by San Jose in 2010 (5th Round, 127th overall).

#84 Brant Harris: Played in 37 games for the University of Connecticut Huskies, registering 31 points (15 goals, 16 assists). Finished 2nd on the team in points (31) and led the team in goals (15)...In 2011-12 during his sophomore season, scored 33 points which is T-6th all time in UConn D1 history for points in a single season...Attending Prospect Camp as a tryout

#87 Max Gaede: Played in 41 games with Minnesota State-Mankato, registering 11 points (one goal, 10 assists). Named to the 2012-13 WCHA All-Academic Team...Won a gold medal as a member of Team USA at World Junior A Classic in Penticton, B.C. in 2010...Drafted by San Jose in the 2010 (3rd Round, 88th overall).

#89 Mark Cooper: During his freshman year at Bowling Green University, Cooper posted 16 points (nine goals, seven assists) and 18 PIMs. He was named co-rookie of the year and ranked 3rd on the team in goals (9)...Attending Prospect Camp as a tryout.

Defensemen

#41 Mirco Mueller: In 63 games with the Everett Silvertips, Mueller registered 31 points (six goals, 25 assists) and 57 PIMs. He was T-2nd on his team in points (31) and ranked 2nd amongst all WHL rookie d-men in points. Mueller was also named Everett's Rookie of the Year...Represented Switzerland at the 2013 IIHF World Jr. Championships, picking up two assists in six games. At the 2012 U-18 World Championships, he posted three points (one goal, two assists) in five games...Drafted by San Jose in 2013 (1st Round, 18th overall).

#47 Joakim Ryan: Played in 34 games with Cornell University, posting 23 points (three goals, 20 assists) and 12 PIMs. Finished the season T-3rd on his team in points (23), 1st overall in assists (20), and 6th in the entire nation in assists per game by a defenseman (0.59 A/GP)...Drafted by San Jose in 2012 (7th Round, 198th overall).

#51 Konrad Abeltshauser: Named to the 2013 Memorial Cup All-Star team...Amongst all QMJHL defensemen in 2012-13, finished the postseason ranked 1st in points per game (1.18 PTS/GP), 2nd in goals per game (0.41 G/GP), and 3rd in assists per game (0.76 A/GP). Finished the regular season ranked 3rd in assists (47) and 5th in points (54)...Drafted by San Jose in 2010 (6th Round, 163rd overall).

#64 Isaac MacLeod: Played in 36 games with Boston College, posting seven points (two goals, five assists), 16 PIMs, and a +1 rating. Has earned Hockey East All-Academic Team honors twice in his career at Boston College...Drafted by San Jose in 2010 (5th Round, 136th overall).

#70 Bigos, Kyle: Played 30 games for Merrimack College, posting 11 points (four goals, seven assists) and 111 PIMs. Bigos was a four-time Hockey East Top Performer and was named to the Catamount Cup All-Tournament Team on Dec. 30, 2012...Acquired by San Jose via trade with Edmonton on July 6, 2013.

#74 Dylan Demelo: Named to OHL's Subway Super Series team...In 64 games with Mississauga in the OHL, Demelo posted 50 points (15 goals, 35 assists) in 64 games played. He finished the regular season T-5th amongst OHL defenseman in goals (15) and T-7th in points (50)...Drafted by San Jose in 2011 (6th Round, 179th overall).

#81 Adam Comrie: In 45 games with Reading in the ECHL, played 45 games and posted 33 points (17 goals, 16 assists) to go along with a +22 rating and 106 PIMs. He finished 1st amongst all ECHL defenseman in goals (17) and 10th amongst all skaters in plus-minus (+22)...In 24 games with the Worcester Sharks, Comrie registered 15 points (three goals, 12 assists), a +2 rating and 24 penalty minutes...Signed by San Jose as a free agent on July 10, 2013.

Goaltenders

#33 Fredrik Bergvik: Played 14 games for U-20 Frolunda of the Swedish Elite League, posting a 1.29 GAA, .950 SV%, and 4 shutouts...Drafted by San Jose in 2013 (4th Round, 117th overall).

#36 J.P. Anderson: Set the all-time record for wins by an Ontario Hockey League goaltender by recording his 115th career win on Dec 9, 2012 against Sault Ste. Marie...Played 53 games for the Sarnia Sting, posting a 26-21-5 record, 3.31 GAA, .905 SV% and one shutout...Signed by San Jose as a free agent on Sept. 21, 2010.

Forwards

#40 Sebastian Stalberg: In his first professional season Stalberg played 66 games with Worcester, registering 18 points (10 goals, eight assists), 10 PIMs, and 134 shots. He ranked 2nd on the team in shots (134)...Signed by San Jose as a free agent on Mar. 14, 2012.

#45 Gabryel Boudreau: Played 67 games for Baie-Comeau in his first year in the QMJHL, posting 63 points (22 goals, 41 assists), 43 PIMs and a +31 rating. He ranked 5th on his team in goals (22), T-1st on his team in assists (41), 4th on his team in points (63), and T-2nd on his team in +/- (+31)...Drafted by San Jose in 2013 (2nd Round, 49th overall).

#48 Tomas Hertl: Played 43 games for HC Slavia Praha, registering 30 points (18 goals, 12 assists) and a +5 rating. Finished the regular season tied for 18th in the Czech Extraliga in goals (18)...Finished the postseason tied for 2nd on his team in assists (5), 3rd in points (8), and T-3rd on his team in goals (3)...Won gold with the Czech Republic at the 2012 Karjala Cup...Competed for the Czech Republic at the 2013 IIHF World Championships...Served as Assistant Captain for the Czech Republic's at the 2013 World Junior Championships. He finished tied for 2nd in points (5), 2nd in assists (3), and 4th in goals (2) on his team at the tournament...Drafted by San Jose in 2012 (1st Round, 17th overall).

#55 Petter Emanuelsson: In 54 games with Skelleftea HC of the Swedish Elite League, Emanuelsson posted 18 points (nine goals, nine assists) and a +9 rating...Signed by San Jose as a free agent on June 11, 2013.

#58 Jake Jackson: Played in 25 games for Tartan Senior High, scoring 56 points (29 goals, 27 assists) and 10 PIMs...In 21 games with Team Northeast of the USHS, Jackson registered 14 points (10 goals, four assists) and 10 PIMs...Finalist for Minnesota's Mr. Hockey award last winter...Drafted by San Jose in 2013 (7th Round, 201st overall).

#63 James Livingston: Played in 67 games with the Worcester Sharks, registering 21 points (seven goals, 14 assists). Livingston ranked 1st on the team in +/- rating (+13) and was voted the Sharks Unsung Hero Award...Signed by San Jose as a free agent on Mar. 11, 2011.

#65 Daniel O'Regan: Invited to the 2013 USA Hockey National Junior Evaluation Camp...As a freshman at Boston University, O'Regan registered 38 points (16 goals, 22 assists), four game-winning goals, and a +2 rating. He finished the regular season T-2nd on his team in goals (16) and 1st overall in points (38). O'Regan ranked 32nd overall in the nation for points per game (0.97 PTS/GP), and T-4th in the nation for points per game by a freshman. He was also named to the College Hockey News' 2012-13 All-Rookie Team...Won a gold-medal with Team USA squad at the 2012 U-18 World Championships, tallying 10 points (four goals, 6 assists) in 14 games played...Drafted by San Jose in 2012 (5th Round, 138th overall).

#68 Reed Seckel: Played 35 games for Northern Michigan University and served as Assistant Captain, registering 25 points (13 goals, 12 assists) and a +3 rating. He finished 1st on the team in goals (13) and 2nd on the team in assists (12)...Attending Prospect Camp as a tryout.

#76 Eriah Hayes: Served as a team captain for Minnesota State University and was an All-WCHA Third Team selection...Posted 36 points (20 goals, 16 assists) in 41 games. Ranked 2nd on the team in points (36), 2nd in the nation in power play goals (12), 12th in the nation in goals (20), and 1st in the nation in shots (186)...Signed by San Jose as a free agent on Apr. 5, 2013.

#82 Christophe Lalancette: Serves as an alternate captain for Acadie-Bathurst...Finished the regular season 5th on his team in assists (37) and 5th in points (55)...Finished the postseason 1st on his team in points (7) and tied for 1st in goals (4)...Drafted by San Jose in 2012 (4th Round, 109th overall).

#83 Matthew Nieto: In 39 games with Boston University, Nieto potted 37 points (18 goals, 19 assists), six power play goals, a +5 rating and 24 PIMs. He finished the NCAA season 1st on his team in goals (18) and 2nd on his team in points (37). Furthermore, Nieto ranked 25th in the nation in goals per game (0.46 G/GP) and 39th in the nation in points per game (0.95 PTS/GP). In 11 games with the Worcester Sharks, Nieto racked up six points (two goals, four assists) and posted an assist in his first professional game on Apr. 2...Drafted by San Jose in 2011 (2nd Round, 47th overall).

#85 Curt Gogol: Played in 38 games with Worcester, potting six points (four goals, two assists) and 7 fighting majors. Gogol finished 2nd on the team with 139 PIMs...Signed by San Jose as a free agent on Sept. 21, 2010.

#86 Sean Kuraly: Won a gold medal with Team USA at the 2013 World Junior Championships, registering three points (one goal, two assists) in seven games...In 40 games with Miami of Ohio, posted 12 points (six goals, six assists) and 41 PIMs...Drafted by San Jose in 2011 (5th Round, 133rd overall).

#90 Riley Brace: Played 66 games for Mississauga in the OHL, registering 73 points (21 goals, 52 assists) and 89 PIMs. Ranked 2nd on his team in goals (21), 1st on his team in assists (52), and 1st on his team in points (73)...Amongst all OHL players, Brace ranked 8th in assists (52) and T-18th in points (73) and was named the OHL's 3rd smartest player, 3rd best playmaker, and 3rd best penalty killer in the annual OHL Eastern Conference Coaches Poll...Signed by Worcester as a free agent on Apr. 5, 2013.

Defensemen

#49 Clifford Watson: In 58 games with the Sioux City Musketeers, Watson posted eight points (two goals, six assists), a +5 rating, and 65 PIMs...Drafted by San Jose in 2012 (6th Round, 168th overall).

#53 Gage Ausmus: Played 62 games for the U.S. National U-18 team in the USHL, registering 14 points (two goals, 12 assists), 54 PIMS and a +22...Committed to the University of North Dakota in the fall...Drafted by San Jose in 2013 (5th Round, 151st overall).

#59 Zach Palmquist: In 41 games with Minnesota State-Mankato, Palmquist registered 25 points (seven goals, 18 assists). He ranked 18th in the nation in scoring by defenseman with (25 points). Furthermore, Palmquist was named the WCHA Defensive Player of the Week on Nov. 3, 2012 and was named 2012-13 WCHA All-Academic...In 38 games as a freshman in 2011-12, Palmquist led all team-defenseman in points with 19 (six goals, 13 assists)...Has not missed a game in his two-year MSU career (79 games played)...Attending Prospect Camp as a tryout.

#62 Sena Acolatse: During his second professional season, played 50 games with Worcester and posted 21 points (4 goals, 17 assists), 62 PIMS, and 86 shots...Signed by San Jose as a free agent on Mar. 4, 2011.

#77 Taylor Doherty: Played in 40 games with Worcester, registering 10 points (one goal, nine assists), 67 PIMs, and five fighting majors...Drafted by San Jose in 2009 (2nd Round, 57th overall).

#80 Matt Tennyson: First player developed by the San Jose Jr. Sharks program to play in the NHL for the San Jose Sharks...Registered two assists in four games played with San Jose, including an assist in his first NHL game against Vancouver on Apr. 1. In 60 games with Worcester, posted 27 points (five goals, 22 assists) and 44 penalty minutes. At the time of his recall to San Jose he ranked 1st amongst all Worcester defenseman in goals, points and assists...Signed by San Jose as a free agent on Mar. 29, 2012.

Goaltenders

#30 Steve Racine: Played 24 games as a freshman at the University of Michigan, posting a 12-6-3 record, 2.65 GAA, and .899 SV%...Was named to CCHA All-Tournament Team as he started every game of the CCHA tournament in net as Michigan advance to the championship game...Named CCHA Rookie of the Week on Mar. 2, 2013...Attending Prospect Camp as tryout

#34 Troy Grosenick: In 34 games with Union College, Grosenick posted a 17-10-5 record, 2.12 GAA, .926 SV% and .609 winning percentage, ranking him 4th amongst all ECAC goaltenders in each category. In 2011-12, Grosenick led all ECAC goaltenders in GAA (1.65), SV% (.936) and winning percentage (.758), while posting a 22-6-3 record. He was named First-Team AHCA All-American, the Ken Dryden Award as ECAC Hockey Goaltender of the Year, and was a Hobey Baker Award finalist...Signed by San Jose as a free agent on Apr. 8, 2013.
